Information on Herbs used in the Treatment

Sheng Di Huang

Actions: Clear heat, cool blood, nourish yin and generate fluid.

It enhances immunity, balances endocrine system and it also demonstrated anti-inflammatory, cardiogenic, anti-hypertensive, hemostatic, hepatoprotective, diuretic, and antibiotic effects. It is widely used for urticaria, arthritis, and vertebral hyperostosis, etc.

Niu Bang Zi

Actions: Clear wind heat, remove toxins, clear throat and treat inflammatory swelling.

It has antibiotic, antidiabetic, anti-inflammatory, antipyretic and diuretic effects. It also promotes the functions of kidneys.

Sheng Ma

Actions: lower blood pressure and balance heart rate.

It has antibiotic, antipyretic, and mild anti-inflammatory and analgesic effects. It is used for gastric and rectal prolapses.

Shi Gao

Actions:

Shi Gao has antipyretic action but no diaphoretic effect. It improves the healing of broken bones (topical use) and stimulates immune system. It facilitates the passage of bile, shortens coagulation time and promotes diuresis, etc.

It is used for osteoarthritis deformans edemica, fever, acute sprain (topical), burns (topical), etc.

Bai Shao

Actions: improve immunity, demonstrate marked sedative and suppressant effects on CNS (central nervous system) and protective effect against seizures. It dilates coronary and peripheral arteries slightly lower the blood pressure. It also has inhibitory influence on the smooth muscles of the intestines and uterus. By inhibiting the secretion of gastric acid, it treats peptic ulcers. Bai Shao also has anti-inflammatory, antibiotic, antipyretic effects.

Indications: pains, muscle spasm and twitching, myotonia, habitual constipation, peptic ulcer, hyperosteoarthritis, restless leg syndrome, cough, asthma, diabetes, etc.

Jin Yin Hua

It has antibiotic, anti-inflammatory, antipyretic, antihyperlipidemic effects. It increases the motility of the stomach and intestines, increases the excretion of bile acid and gastric acid, and slightly stimulates the CNS.

It is used for mastitis, common cold, upper respiratory infection and appendicitis, etc.

Zhi Mu

Zhi Mu has anti-diabetic, antibiotic, antipyretic effects and it is used for prostatic hypertrophy, acute rheumatism, etc.

Xuan Shen

Xuan Shen has antihypertensive, antidiabetic, antibiotic and some sedative and antipyretic effects and it

is used for peeling of the skin.

Bai Mao Gen

Bai Mao Gen has hemostatic, diuretic, antibiotic effects. It is used for epidemic hemorrhagic fever, epistaxis and nephritis, etc.

Fang Feng

Fang Feng has antibiotic and antipyretic effects and it is used for antidote for arsenic poisoning, chronic lower back pain, etc.

Jing Jie

Jing Jie has antipyretic, diaphoretic, antibiotic, hemostatic and analgesic effects. It relieves bronchospasm and is used for dermatological disorders such as measles, pruritic rash, itching, etc.

Gan Cao

Gan Cao has antitoxin, hepatoprotective, antitussive, expectorant, analgesic, antibiotic, and antihyperlipidemic effects.

Gan Cao has variety of indications including endocrine system disorders, Addison's disease, peptic ulcers, TB, hepatitis, arrhythmia, back and leg pain, purpura, intestinal spasm, food and mushroom poisoning, profuse urination, tonsillitis, phlebitis, acute mastitis, frost bite, etc.

Mineralocorticoid effects----increased---re-absorption of sodium and water and excretion of potassium

Glucocorticoid effect, enhance and duration of cortisone.

Anti-inflammatory, antiarrhythmic, regulate immune system, treat peptic ulcers, stop spasm and cramps of intestines and uterus.
